

PH EMBASSY JOINS FILIPINO MUSLIMS IN LIBYA IN CELEBRATING EID'L FITR



Tripoli, 02 May 2022 – More than a hundred Muslim members of the Filipino Community in Libya gathered at the Philippine Embassy grounds in Janzour City for the Eid'l Fitr Salah or morning prayer. The event, hosted by the Embassy, marks the end of the month-long fasting of our Muslim brothers and sisters during Ramadan.
